

Evaluation of the year 2019

Most Poles assess the past year as good personally (73%) and for their families (72%). The level of satisfaction in the personal and family sphere is currently the highest in the history of CBOS research, i.e. since the late 1980s. Most employees (63%) declare that 2019 was a good year for their workplaces. Estimates of the situation in workplaces are slightly worse than a year and two years ago, but they are among the best since 1989.

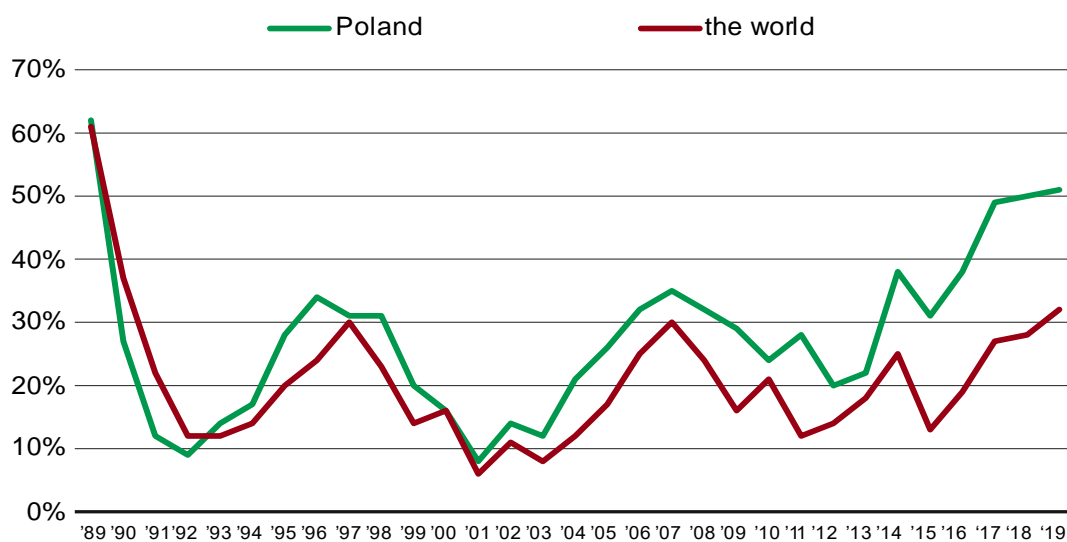
Traditionally, national and global assessments of the past year are worse than those relating to the private and professional sphere. Just over half (51%) believe that 2019 was a good year for Poland. The last three years have been rated as the best for Poland since the breakthrough year 1989. Almost a third (32%) describe the last year as good for the world. Also in this dimension, the ratings are among the best.
